

Crimson Trails is a network of walking and running routes, featuring multiple levels of difficulty over varying distances. The routes are spread across the UA campus, River Walk path and into the downtown area of Tuscaloosa. Including the two existing routes around the Quad and the Student Recreational Center, there will be a total of six routes.

The purpose of Crimson Trails is to spark the community's participation and interest in cardiovascular exercise by providing various safe, scenic running paths in and around the University of Alabama campus.



EXISTING ROUTES

Quad Loop: 2/3 miles per lap; 3 laps = 2 miles

Student Recreation Center Loop: 1 2/3 miles per lap

UA 5K: 3.1 miles. Begin/Finish: Student Recreation Center

UA Residential: 3.8 miles Begin/Finish: Student Recreation Center

Quad Loop: .77 miles Begin/finish: Quad

Rec Loop: 1.56 Miles Begin/finish: Student Recreation Center





There will be a total of thirteen DecoMark trail markers located throughout Crimson Trails.




